



Invitation to the Wushu Swiss Open 2019

When	Sunday 24 th of March 2019
Where	Erlenweg 12, 5036 Oberentfelden , Switzerland Aarau
Tournament	Taolu (traditional and modern), Qingda (light-contact) and Sanda (full-contact)
Participation	All Wushu and Kung Fu schools from foreign countries as well as national teams will be allowed to participate to the Wushu Swiss Open. (Swiss schools must be affiliate to swisswushu and participants need a valid licence.)
Participation rules	Participation to several disciplines in taolu or in combat is authorised. However combat disciplines authorises registration to only one weight category. Men and woman are in separate categories. No mixed combats.
Registration	<p>1. Request of the licence for all participants must be sent until 10th February 2019 the latest at info@swisswushu.ch.</p> <p>2. Then registration of the starts has to be performed through our web-portal https://swisswushu.softpulse.ch till latest 17th February 2019. A login will be sent to you by e-mail. (Registration account). Fees	<p>Adults CHF 40.00 Children / Juniors CHF 30.00</p> <p>License CHF 20.00 (each athlete & coach needs a tournament licence)</p> <p>Demands for reimbursement for late registrations will not be accepted. Supply of medical certificate does not give you the right to a reimbursement.</p>
Fees payment	The bill for the fees and for the licences will be sent by e-mail after the end of registration. Please pay your bill in time.
Request of Licences	<p>Time limit: Sunday, 10th February 2019 Licences asked after the date will not be taken in account.</p>
Limit for registration (start)	<p>Taolu and combat: Sunday, 17th February 2019 Athletes registered after this date will not be allowed to participate to the open.</p>



Fusion of categories	If not enough people are registered for a category, the organizers keep the right to fuse two categories. This is valid for taolu and combat categories. Ideally a minimum of 4 participants is requested to validate a category. In combat, if the category has only one registration and if a fusion with the upper category is not feasible; the fusion will take place with the nearest lower category. Categories with less than 4 participants can be fused with closest neighbouring category (upper or lower).	
Schedule	The approximate schedules for taolu and combats will be published ~1 week before the tournament at the latest, on the websites www.swisswushu.ch and www.swisswushu.ch/wso	
Ranking	A medal will be awarded to the first 3.	
Weigh-in of the fighters	Timing for the weigh-in of the fighters will be given after the end of the registrations . Fighters that do not show on time will be excluded from the tournament. Recall: no category change will be allowed the day of the open . Fighters who will be weighed out of range (to heavy) will be disqualified.	
Equipment	All rules concerning clothing, protections and weapons must be taken in account. In case of doubts, the chief referee can verify the equipment the day of the tournament.	
Coach	Until 5 athletes by team:	2 coaches
	From 6 to 10 athletes by team:	3 coaches
	From 11 athletes by team:	4 coaches
	Coaches must possess a valid licence from swisswushu and must be registered in the web-portal.	
Referee	foreign schools have the possibility to make available a referee. (Please indicate the discipline and the schooling on the application form for licences)	
Entrance fee	Observer adult: CHF 15.- / juniors up to 16 years CHF 8.- Children under 7 years free entrance.
